RoboGaston 2015 Saturday, March 5 East Gaston High School, 1744 Lane Road, Mount Holly, NC 28120 Gastonia East Rotary is sponsoring the Gaston County Schools robot competition for 2015. The event will be held at East Gaston High School the first weekend of March.

The RoboGaston competition provides our local students with an opportunity to not only develop robotic skills that will be important in the new economy, but many other skills that will serve them well in their education and life outside of the classroom. Students learn to problem solve and plan as they develop their solution to central concept problem they are presented with. They also learn how to present their solutions to strangers and how to respond to questions. These interview skills will provide them a level of comfort that will allow them to sit across from a potential employer. Lastly, the students learn how to apply STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) lessons to the real world.

The intangible piece of this puzzle is the team work part of the competition that allows all of these students to fit in and bring their particular skills to the group. Some of these students do not have the interest or skill to participate in athletics and this is



a place where they can come together with other students to flourish as a member of a team.

Gastonia East Rotarians will join with other community leaders and educators to judge the competition's various elements. Training will be provided the morning of the event. Our Rotarians will need to be at East Gaston High School at 7:30 AM. The day will conclude with awards at approximately 2:30 PM. Both breakfast and lunch will be served as a part of the day.
